- (3) <u>Section 1.2 (page 18)</u> For these problems, you may not use a computing device: 5, 6, 10, 18, 20, 29, 31, 34, 44
- (4) Section 1.3 (page 34) For these problems, you may not use a computing device: 1, 2, 8, 11, 13, 15, 19, 23, 24, 26, 28, 30, 34, 47, 48
