GROUP PROJECT: GROUP EVALUATION RUBRIC

This form is used for peer evaluation for group work. You will determine the total number of Group Evalution Points to assign each member of your group.

- 1. Have a group meeting and ensure that all members of your group are present.
- 2. Write down the names of your group members in the space provided below.
- 3. Let n be the number of people in your group (i.e. n=3 or 4). Your group is allotted 15n Group Evaluation Points.
- 4. Subdivide the number of points you believe each member of your group should receive based on their contribution to the Group Project. Write the number of Group Evaluation Points each group member should receive in the space below. (In particular, the sum of the number of points the second column should equal 15n).
- 5. Have each member of your group sign below indicating their approval of the Group Evaluation Point allocation.

For example, if all members of your group contributed equally to the Group Project then each group member will receive 15 Group Evaluation Points. If someone contributed substantially more/less work than other group members then they may receive more/less than 15 Group Evaluation Points.
